In 1996 the Family Radio System (FRS) was approved for use in the United States. Use of FRS frequencies requires no license and their location in the FM band suffers from far less interference than CB radio transmissions. Today, most personal two-way radios are

hybrids, combining FRS frequencies with General Mobile Radio Service (GMRS) frequencies, which provide longer range reception. Use of GMRS frequencies reguires an FCC license and fee that covers a single user and their immediate family.
